

MPF Conservation and the National Park Service invite you to an Open House and showing of two dozen pieces of Historic Mason Monterey furniture from the Oregon Caves National Monument.

The pieces on exhibit are part of a larger collection. This may be the only time you will view this furniture altogether; once it returns to the Oregon Caves it will be divided among various rooms at the Chateau and in the Monument's museum collection.



Colorful Monterey furniture was made by Imperial, Del Rey, Coronado, Brown & Saltman, and the Mason Bros.

Oregon hosts two of the largest public collections in the world: an Imperial line at the Superintendent's home at Crater Lake NP, and the Mason Monterey collection of 300 pieces at the Oregon Caves NM.

Kate & Mitchell Powell, will be on hand to meet and discuss conservation processes and the history of the largest public collection of Mason Monterey furniture in the world. Images of the restoration process will be displayed next to the completed furniture.
